August 27

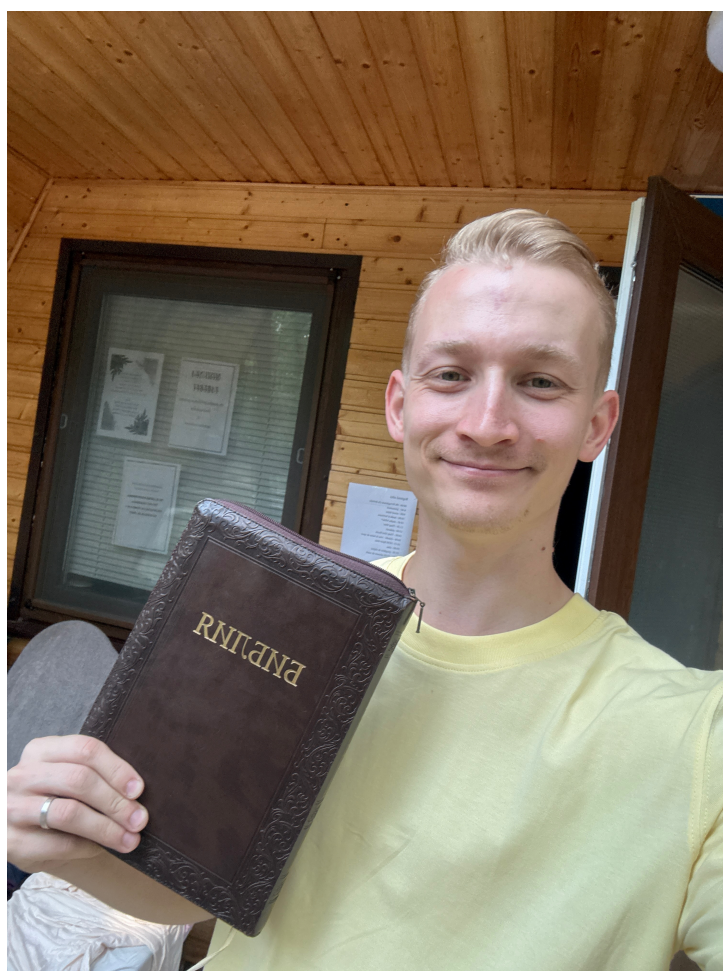
