Many teens are reaching out to our prayer helpline struggling with suicidal thoughts. Please pray that God would show His mercy, touch their hearts, and open them to hear His Word. May they find true love, hope, and healing in the Lord.



September 2

Please pray for Dinmukhammed, one of our listeners from southern Kazakhstan. He wants to learn more about the New Testament and is asking sincere questions about Jesus and the Trinity. Please pray that God would open his heart to the truth and lead him to salvation in Christ.

September 3

Please pray for Natalia, one of our listeners from Novosibirsk, Russia. During a personal crisis, she began searching for the meaning of life, listening to our programs, and reading the Bible more thoughtfully. This project is also focused on reaching the younger generation, with content that will be more informative and different in style from our current work. It is still in the very beginning stages, so please pray for God's grace and wisdom as we develop the content, organize the project, and build the right team.

Please pray for the evangelistic concert that our team member Masha held in a café in Russia this July. Many listeners came, and Masha shared the parable of the prodigal son with a completely secular audience.
